Step 1 - How do I find Glow?

When you are in school there will be an icon on your desktop which will take you to the main Glow login page.

At home, search for **Glow login** on the Internet and choose the **RM Unify** link from your results.

Step 2 - Logging into Glow

Log into the Glow screen with your username and password.

Step 3 - Logging in for the first time

You will be asked to change your password the first time you log into Glow. The new password should contain:

- A capital letter.
- A special character i.e. space, underscore, exclamation mark.
- At least seven characters.

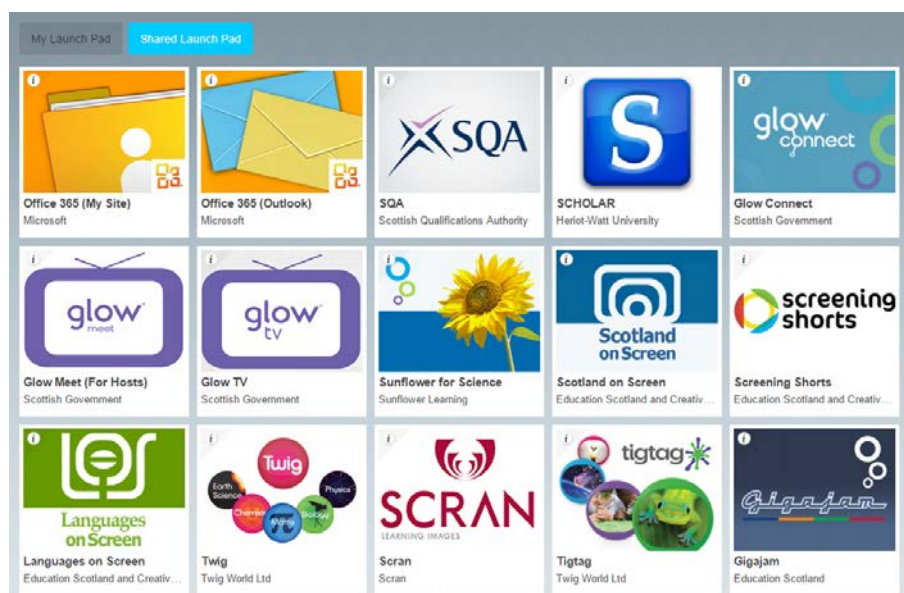

Step 5 - My Launch Pad

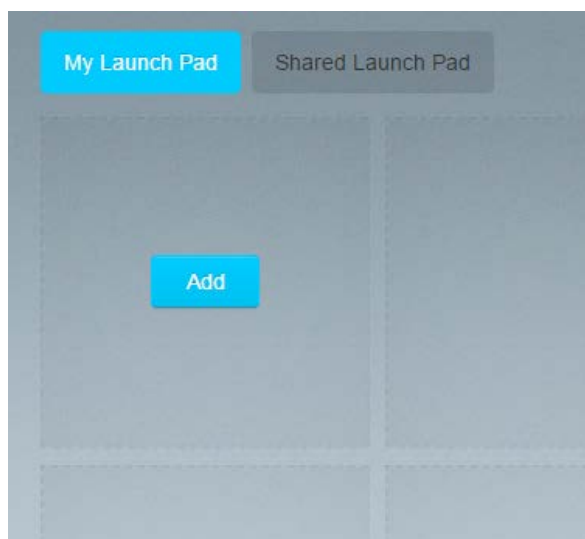
The My Launch Pad function allows you to bookmark the areas of Glow you use on a regular basis. All the functions available in Glow are accessible from home: on tablet, iPad, mobile and/or home computer; all that is needed is an Internet connection.

Step 6 - Personalising your Launch Pad

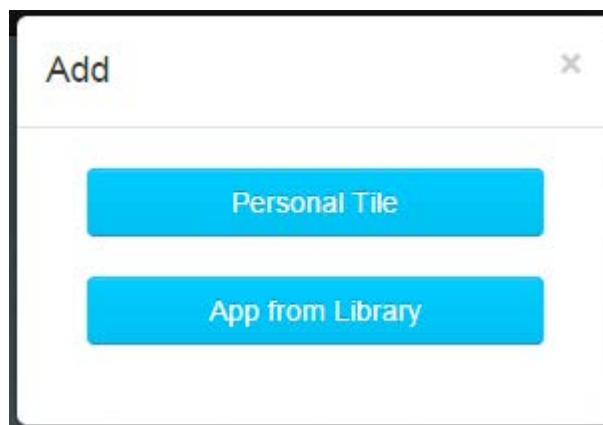
As a starting point you should add:

- Office 365 (Outlook)
Outlook will be the email facility you can use in and out of school.
- Office 365 (My Site)
Personal space for saving work.
- Office 365 (School Site)
Site where staff will post resources.

To add tiles or applications to your **My Launch Pad**, click on **Add**.



Choose to **Add** an **App from Library**.





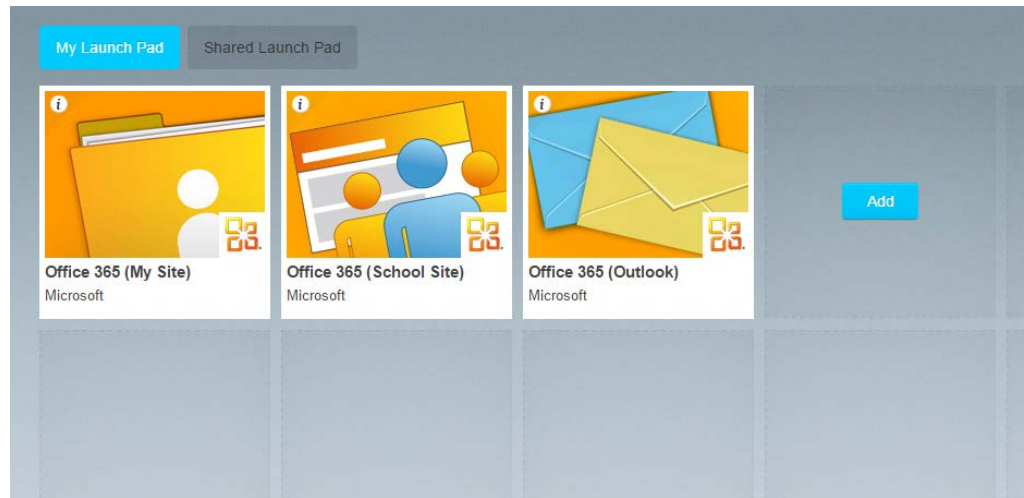
Search for Microsoft
